



Youth Art Intensive Workshop Guidelines

Join artist Lucinda Penn (LCND) for a transformative Youth Art Intensive Workshop. Based on Kurna Land in Adelaide, Australia, Lucinda's work combines art and design to explore human experiences through symbolic objects and contrasting colours. In this workshop, themed "What living in Burnside means to you," participants will engage in both an individual and collaborative art projects. The workshop includes a presentation of Lucinda's murals and paintings, educational activities like word association and symbolic design, and discussions on colour palettes. Students will paint base colours, transfer their sketches onto individual canvases, and have solo painting time to develop their pieces. Additionally, they will work together on a large collaborative canvas for the Burnside community to be displayed in the Youth Space at the City of Burnside Civic Centre. This is a unique chance for young artists to learn from a professional, collaborate with peers, and contribute to a meaningful community art project.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must live, work or study within the City of Burnside.
- Applicants must be aged between 13 - 18 years.
- Applicants must submit at least 3 photographs of their previous completed work.
- Applicants must commit to attending the three full day workshop dates.

How to Enter

All entrants must complete all sections of the application form and submit at least 3 photographs of their previous completed work.

Assessment of Applications

Proposed artwork will be assessed by the Council staff.

- Applicants agree to allow their work to be exhibited and photographed by the City of Burnside.
- Photographs may be reproduced in City of Burnside promotional material to be used by Council at its discretion.
- Personal information collected is held and used by Council under the provisions of the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998.
- Applicants are required to attend the three full day workshops.
