Commonwealth Seniors Health Card Information for Self-Funded Retirees

The Commonwealth Seniors Health Card (CSHC) helps senior Australians with the cost of prescription medicines and other health services if you are of pension age but do not qualify for the Age Pension. You can apply for the Commonwealth Seniors Health Card by phoning Centrelink on 13 23 00 or visiting your nearest Centrelink Customer Service Centre or via the Human Services website at https://www.humanservices.gov.au/individuals/services/centrelink/commonwealth-seniors-health-card/claiming

Cancelling a Home Support and/or Home Maintenance Service

All cancellations require 24 hours' notice. Where 24 hours' notice is not provided, participants will be charged the usual contribution fee for their missed service. This also includes where a contractor has arrived for a pre-scheduled service and you are not home, resulting in a missed service.
