



Tree Species Fact Sheet

River Red Gum

Eucalyptus camaldulensis

An iconic species that can develop into a large, striking amenity tree. Ideally suited to reserves and large verges due to the crown dimensions the tree can reach at maturity.





Height: 10-35m

Crown Spread: 10-35m

Type: Large amenity tree

Origin: NSW, VIC, SA, southern QLD, northern WA

Evergreen/Deciduous: Evergreen

-  **Flower:** Borne on umbels in 7-11, white flower
-  **Bark:** Pale grey-cream to faint yellow/pink, brown
-  **Fruit:** Capsule, ~5mmx10mm, exerted valves
-  **Foliage:** Dull green-grey, lanceolate, pendulous
